



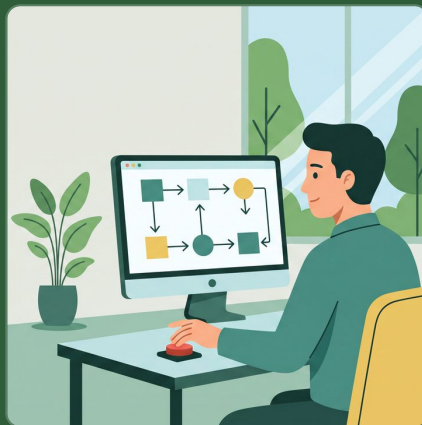

The most-asked-for curriculum, and the one that starts by talking you out of it: first when an agent is the wrong answer, then building one without servers, running it reliably, selling it to clients, and the guardrails that keep it from becoming an invoice.

What you can do afterwards.

Not a list of topics — a list of things you will be able to do. Each one is checked by the final exam at the end of the curriculum.

- 1 Separate the three things the market calls “agent”: a chat assistant, an automation, and an agent that plans, calls tools and loops.
- 2 Judge a task against four questions — repetitive, judged, reversible, observable — and say no out loud when it fails them.
- 3 Build a working assistant in an afternoon without a server, and name the ceiling of that stage.
- 4 Handle what nobody demos: retries, partial failure, duplicate runs, and a ceiling that stops a loop from becoming an invoice.
- 5 Scope a client engagement so “done” is testable: named inputs, named outputs, an acceptance list, a written non-goal.

FIT

Who this is for

- Your boss or your client said “build us an agent” and you need to know what that means before you agree.
- You have automated something once and it broke in a way nobody noticed for two weeks.
- You want to sell agent projects and need a scope that does not end in an open-ended argument.

And who it is not for

Not for you if you want a framework tour.
The setup is taught as a ladder — assistant, hosted platform, managed hosting, own server — and your own laptop as a starting point does not appear at all.

The story it is taught in: Noor Haddad automates their own team's work first and only then sells the capability — evenings and weekends, no engineering team.

THE COURSES

Every course, in order.

Each one is a full course with chapters, exercises, a final test and its own course certificate. The first episode of course 1 plays on the website without an account.

The curriculum ends in a real exam — one you can fail. The certificate carries a public identifier, so a client, an employer or a partner can check it themselves. That is the whole point of this school.

Start with the first episode. It is free, it needs no account, and it tells you in ten minutes whether this is for you.
